

A family's life can be turned upside down when they receive the devastating news that their child is sick and they will need to travel for specialist medical care. Often, they simply cannot afford to stay in hotels while their child receives treatment for extended periods of time.

RMHC SEQ cares for families with children who are ill or injured. We provide essential services that remove barriers, strengthen families, and promote healing when children need healthcare, including vital accommodation. We are not diagnosis specific and support all medical conditions.

Ronald McDonald Houses provide a homely and inviting place for parents, guardians, carers and siblings to stay while their child is undergoing treatment in a nearby hospital.

We have three Houses:

- Ronald McDonald House Herston: adjacent to the Royal Brisbane & Women's Hospital
- Ronald McDonald House South Brisbane, directly opposite the Queensland Children's Hospital and Mater Mothers' Hospital
- Ronald McDonald House in Queensland Children's Hospital; specifically to support patients of the Paediatric Intensive Care Unit

Our Houses offer private units where families can rest and find sanctuary, as well as communal spaces where they can relax, unwind, and connect with others. We aspire to provide all the comforts of home for adults and children alike.

- Every year, around 3,500 families travel to Brisbane or the Gold Coast so their sick or injured child can receive specialist medical treatment.
- Families stay with us for 7.5 days on average; however, some families have needed our accommodation for as long as 700 nights.
- Some families travel as far as 600 kilometres and many need to come multiple times through the duration of their child's treatment.

On average, it costs \$160 a night to cover the necessary costs associated with maintaining a room for a family, including all linen, electricity, cleaning, and general maintenance. That's more than \$58,000 per year, per room.

The cost of providing a home away from home for families with ill or injured children currently exceeds \$10 million a year and these costs are increasing. As a not-for-profit organisation, we rely on the generous support of individuals, community and corporate partners to ensure our doors stay open for families when they need us the most.
